THE GUJARAT TOWN PLANNING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT ACT, 1976

No.GH/V/70 of 2012/TPS-1410-1880-L: WHEREAS, under section 41(1) of the Gujarat Town Planning and Urban Development Act, 1976 (President's Act No. 27 of 1976) (hereinafter referred to as "the said Act") Surat Municipal Corporation (hereinafter referred to as "the said Authority") declared its intention of making of the Draft Town Planning Scheme No. 81 (Dummas) (hereinafter referred to as "the said Draft Scheme")

AND WHEREAS, under section 42(1) of the said Act, the said Authority made and published, duly in the prescribed manner in respect of the area included in the said Draft Scheme

AND WHEREAS, after taking into consideration, objection or suggestion received by the said Authority. The said Authority submitted the said Draft Scheme to the State Government for sanction under section 48(1) of the said Act, in the manner provided therein;

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 48(2) of the said Act the, Government of Gujarat hereby:-

- (a) Sanction the said Draft Scheme subject to the modifications enumerated in the Schedule appended hereto;
- (b) State that the said Draft Scheme shall be kept open for inspection by the public, at the office of the said Authority, during office hours on all working days.

SCHEDULE

While finalizing the said Draft Scheme, the Town Planning Officer shall

1. Allot final plots in their original plots or in the near vicinity as far as possible, considering existing construction, NA permission, subdivision & revenue record, use at site with average deduction.


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2. With respect to the discrepancy mentioned in the letter of Municipal Commissioner submitting the said scheme, decide the reconstitution only after getting the opinion of the said authority.
3. Deduct the Govt. lands as well as private lands at par, with the average deduction.
4. Allot the separate original plot/final plot for State Govt. lands as per revenue records.
5. Allot the separate original plot/final plot for excess lands declare under U.L.C. Act.
6. Correct form F, relevant maps and other matters, as well as instead of word reservation mentioned word allotment for the plots allotted to appropriate authority in form E.
7. Carve out the final plots in regular shapes, useable and buildable as per the provisions of the general development control regulation. (R-1, R-18, R-30, R-38, R-45, R-46, R-50, R-62 etc allotted to the appropriate authority)
8. Decide the ownerships, area and tenure as per the revenue records and allot the separate original plot/final plot as per tenure.
9. Check authenticity of the buildings and shall show the sanctioned layout plans and sanctioned building plans on relevant maps.
10. Increase the area for SEWSHS up to 5% of the Scheme area.
11. Maintain talavs and water bodies. (Khadi/Canal etc.) as per original land (original plot no. 38, 58, 60, 62, 125, 143, 168, etc.)
12. Reconstitute original plots in such a fashion so that the telephone line, gas line or electricity line does not affect the final plots.
13. Make proposal, considering width and the alignment of existing and proposed roads of adjoin area.
14. Take necessary decision for the road, in case where the development/building permission has granted considering the existing road or access by other road.
15. Allot final plot numbers for the final plots to appropriate authority in consecutive sequence.
16. Allot final plot in such a fashion that it's become buildable in accordance to provision of General Control Development Regulation.
17. While finalizing the said Draft Scheme, the Town Planning Officer shall make final plots allotted to appropriate authority buildable as per the provisions of the GDCR with regular shape and also decide purpose, area, frontage in the consultation of the Appropriate Authority
18. Review the proposal of 24 mtr wide road in accordance to development plan up to north boundary of the scheme (Road passing through original plot no. 190 to 194, 70, 71, 80 to 82, 94, 95, etc.)

19. Maintain "forest land" as designated in the development plan and assign separate original plots and reconstitute such land in a manner the final plot is same as original plot. Also for all such final plots not to levy any incremental contribution.
20. Maintain development plan reservation (O-58, Sports Complex-SUDA) without reconstitution.
21. Decide the percentage of beneficiaries to the scheme area and general Public in consultation with appropriate authority by considering location, area and use of public purpose.
22. In consultation with Appropriate Authority and the Irrigation Department decide the boundary of embankment/retaining wall or the river line and thereafter for the land on the river side of the embankment/retaining wall/river line assign separate original plots and reconstitute them in a manner the final plot is same as original plot. Also for all such final plots not to levy any incremental contribution.
